## 5. Art, Culture & Celebration

- a) Arts, Culture & Celebration Working Group
  - a. Mural Project Update:
    - i. Funding: increase to \$300.00 from the Go Fund Me account;

- ii. Logistics: second rendering and final logistics for building prep and process obtained. Date not finalized.
- iii. Second mural option for Hampton Park –to be related to basket ball and funded by/for FIBA Olympic Basketball Qualifying Tournament held in Victoria June 29 to July 4
- b. Curb Appeal: 2 week run starting early July.

### 6. Mobility and Transportation

- a) Mobility & Transportation Working Group Sept start date for Gorge Road West changes. Looking at strategy for Tillicum Road that involves lobbying of councillors and at council meetings. Erica will work out schedule of presentations.
- b) Dean Murdoch's initiative no interest from GTCA at this time. Will maintain link with Dean but decline active involvement
- c) Strong Towns: has education materials and resources for lobbying. Talk to Phil if interested in participation as part of academy workshop or for a Strong town tour.
- d) Urban Thrive company that builds gentle infill (project on Richmond). Co is interested in GT neighbourhood. Low rise town homes set to be carless. Infrastructure aligns with GTCA

## 7. <u>Buildings</u> (Developments and other building uses)

- a) Buildings Working Group focused on Tillicum Road working with Transportation and mobility group. Has a videographer and discussing options for video that highlights the GTCA vision for Tillicum Road
- b) Other Development Applications updates
  - Earl Grey Daycare Expansion; see package in minutes. Looking for support. Asking to raise fences to 8 feet for deer fence. Continuing with artificial turf. Action: Vera to send another letter with concerns of GTCA
  - 3143 Tillicum Development Changes to Micro unit (270 sq ft) 6 storey rental proposal. Now want to do condos with strata (to own) due to increased cost of building. This change is big enough to warrant a new meeting with board. Action: Vera to organize meeting.
  - SNP Daycare: wanting support from GTCA for revised development permit to cover changes already
    made (i.e. was originally to be modular but now is a regular 2x4 frame building). There has been
    some modifications to trees and water access as a result with some concern by some neighbours.
    The project is still in zone of Pearkes not Saanich Parks. Action: Send individual letters not letter
    from board.
  - 1 & 21 Obed Ave: 3 storey purpose built rental apartment at Obed and Harriet: waiting for Public hearing. Will not currently commit to paying the Community Amenity (as they are rental) to Saanich.
  - 3400 Tillicum Rd (old bingo hall): approved.
  - El Greco at Gorge & Tillicum: to start this fall (late). Redo restaurant and increase patio space. Action: Vera to talk to group for Art work on hording

### 8. Natural Areas (Green spaces & waterways)

- a) Natural Areas Working Group UVic students continue in collaboration for Pollinator Green Map for GT area. 1500\$ contribution/honorarium that is earmarked for pollinator projects.
- b) Dogs in parks proposal from Saanich staff to maintain dogs on leash Cuthbert Holmes. There is a Cuthbert Holmes management plan to prevent damage to wetlands and bird sanctuary. Motion (Paul) second (Chris B): in order to prevent damage to the wetlands and bird sanctuary, we support the proposal to maintain dogs on leash in Cuthbert Holmes Park. In favor: 11 against: 1 abstain: 2
